drainage incorporated and already there

is severe erosion on the steeper slope to
such an extent that it would now be difficult
to drive on it. The area has been ploughed in
such a manner as to create ideal conditions
for the loss of most of the soil leaving a
permanently ruined landscape - ruined not
only for the pt of view of scenery but for
any agricultural purpose ^{possibly possible} as well.
