Dear Mr Archibald,

The Council of the Baillies of Bannachie is concerned about the lack of toilet facilities at the Pittodrie Car Park.

At the last meeting of the Council, Dr D. Gordon informed the members that the Gordon District Council was unwilling to undertake the provision of toilets this year. The figure mentioned for the Council scheme was £15,000.00. The Baillies feel that this is a large outlay for <sup>toilets</sup> ~~such a function~~ that.

I have been asked to let you know that the Forestry Commission make and supply toilet units - for their own schemes - but also for sale to other authorities (in Banff and

Buchan District has been a customer)  
These toilet units cost £2,300 + 20%  
+ V.A.T.

The Council of the Bailies brings  
this to your notice, as an appropriate  
alternative, bearing in mind too,  
that Mr G.R.I. Smith of Pittodrie will  
give you access to a water supply  
and to a cesspool. Such a unit  
at Pittodrie would also
