Sand and gravel quarries are necessary but they do create problems. The present quarrying at Rothens has been going on for over ten years although the original application was for a much shorter period.

The Bailies of Bennachie feel that this area, which is of high scenic value, has taken rather more than its fair share of despoliation, and if we are to promote the tourism potential of the Bennachie area, this is incompatible with the noise, ugliness and problems of fast-moving, heavy lorries on narrow and unsuitable roads.
